The testimony of his wife is expected to result in an acquittal, but she is a shrew who damages his case and all but hangs him. Then a mysterious woman steps into the sceneWho is this woman? Is she the murderer? Is the young man to be hanged? Innocent or guilty? Plot twists abound in this famous courtroom thriller which was also adapted into a film by the same name.
Sept 20-Oct 6 The Miracle Worker By William Gibson A Heartwarming American Classic Auditions Aug. 11 & 12	Based on the remarkable true story of Helen Keller and her teacher Annie Sullivan, this inspiring and unforgettable play has moved countless readers and become an American classic. Young Helen Keller, blind, deaf, and mute since infancy, is in danger of being sent to an institution because her inability to communicate has left her frustrated and violent. In desperation, her parents seek help from the Perkins Institute, which sends them a "half-blind Yankee schoolgirl" named Annie Sullivan to tutor their daughter. Despite the Kellers' resistance and the belie that Helen "is like a little safe, locked, that no one can open," Annie suspects that within Helen lies the potential for more, if only she can reach her. Through persistence, love, and sheer stubbornness, Annie breaks through Helen's walls of silence and darkness and teaches her to communicate, bringing her into the world at last.
Nov 8-24 Wonder of the World By David Lindsay-Abaire Comedy Auditions Sept. 29 & 30	Nothing will prepare you for the dirty little secret Cass discovers in her husband's sweater drawer. It is so shocking that our heroine has no choice but to flee to the honeymoon capital of the world in a frantic search for the life she thinks she missed out on. It's a wild ride over Niagara Falls in a barrel of laughs as Cass embarks on a journey of self-discovery that has her crossing paths with a blithely suicidal alcoholic, a lonely tour-boat captain, a pair of bickering private detectives and a strange caper involving a gargantuan jar of peanut butter, all of which pushes her perilously close to the water's edge. A wildly entertaining comedy.
Dec 13-29 Mrs. Bob Crachit's Wild Christmas Binge By Christopher Durang Comedy Auditions: Oct. 6 & 7	Mrs. Bob Cratchit's Wild Christmas Binge is a playful, cracked look at the perennial Dickens Christmas classic about mean Ebeneezer Scrooge and his discovering the true meaning of Christmas through the visitation of Three Ghosts. In Durang's giddy version, the Ghost's magic is off, and Scrooge and the Ghost keep showing up at Bob Cratchit's house way too early, where Mrs. Bob Cratchit – a long suffering saint in the Dickens novel – is in a state of fury, hating her life and planning on getting drunk and jumping off the London Bridge. A crazy comedy for that wonderful crazy time of year!
